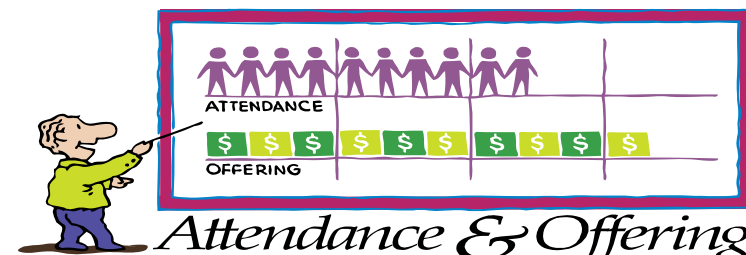

### That's a Weird Name

There are some strange choices that have been made when choosing a mascot. I have no idea what a Philadelphia "Phillie" is. Or a "Charger" or a "Laker". You've probably also heard of the goofy mascots that minor league baseball teams choose - the Montgomery Biscuits, Amarillo Sod Poodles, Rocket City Trash Pandas, etc. etc.

But, as most of you know, I grew up in North Carolina - the "Tar Heel" state. Which is one of the stranger names out there. I was reminded of this name as I was studying for one of our lessons on the armor of God in Ephesians 6, but I didn't have time to include it in the sermon. So, I thought I would save it for the bulletin.

Here's the short version of where "Tar Heels" came from. Large amount of tar, pitch, and turpentine was produced in the state, because of the extensive pine forests. This dates all the way back to pre-Revolutionary War, when North Carolina was a consistent supplier of tar and pitch for England - shipping more than 100,000 barrels annually. They were derisively referred to as "Tar Boilers" in those early years.

But, during the Civil War, in 1863, there were two incidents in which the term was used, and it stuck. Most notably, in a fierce battle in Virginia, when Virginia's troops were driven from the battlefield, North Carolina's troops stood alone and successfully fought back the advancing army. Some Virginians asked in a condescending tone - "Any more tar down in the Old North State, boys?" The quick response was, "No, not a bit. Old Jeff's (Jefferson Davis) bought it up." The Virginians asked, "Is that so? What's he gonna do with it?" To which they replied, "He's gonna put it on you'ns heels to make you stick better in the next fight."

From there, we see multiple references to the troops from North Carolina being referred to as the "Tar Heel Boys." When I read about digging in our heels against the powers of Satan in this world, I can't help but think of Tar Heels. Sometimes I think it would be easier if we actually had some tar on our spiritual heels. We'd give in less frequently. We'd stand our ground for the truth more regularly.

Perhaps we would do well to be reminded more often of these words from the apostle Paul - "Therefore, my beloved brothers, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that in the Lord your labor is not in vain." (1 Corinthians 15:58)

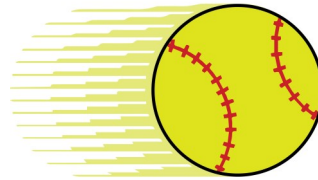

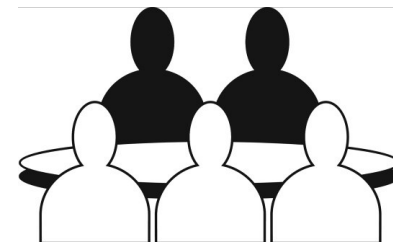
