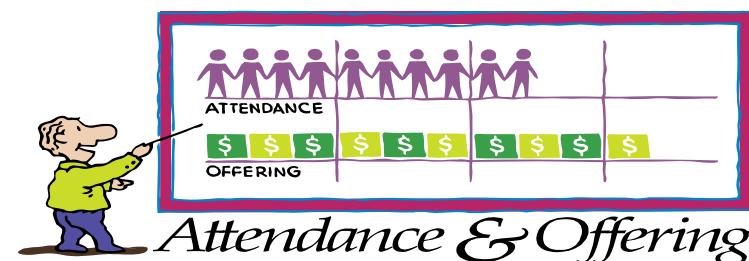

APPRECIATION FROM THE ELDERS

I want to take this opportunity to say thank you from the Elders for your willingness as members of Southside to serve the congregation in the many activities that we have had to participate in this Spring and Summer, especially with our youth. As the Elders have discussed in many of our meetings, our children and grandchildren are the future of the church at Southside, and we need to encourage them in as many ways as possible to learn to love and serve God to the best of their abilities!

There have been several ways that we have encouraged our youth this year:

- Lads to Leaders participation – our youth performed extremely well at the Lads to Leaders convention in Louisville, especially in leading singing, the puppet skits, and in Bible Bowl.
- Kingdom Kids – this has been a tremendous success for Southside in its first year, as the repetition of Bible lessons through crafts, skits, play time activities (to reinforce the lesson), and answering Bible questions using iPads has allowed our youth to truly learn the great lessons of the Bible in a more profound way.
- Bible Bowl at Southside - this one quarter study each Spring has allowed our youth to memorize Scripture, to apply the Bible in their lives, to learn to sing hymns, and to encourage our youth to invite friends.
- Camp Can-Do – a long time activity at Southside, this encourages young children through learning of great Bible lessons, as well as going to Christian Way Farm, the Nature Center at Land Between the Lakes, fishing, and bowling so that they can learn to participate with each other in a group setting.
- Camp Reedy – Southside has the largest group of participants during its week at Camp Reedy each year. Including chaperones, there were over 100 participants at camp this year, which allows our youth to learn about Jesus and to bond together.
- Vacation Bible School – this year, we had 75 youth and 50 adults participate in VBS, of which the theme was Kings and Queens (Solomon, Esther, and Josiah) of the Bible. The youth participated in skits, singing, crafts, play time, and having snacks together.

In all these activities with our youth, it takes an army (God's army) of adult volunteers to make each of these activities the success that they were. Most of the adults at Southside were involved in one or more of these activities. Thank you for your participation!

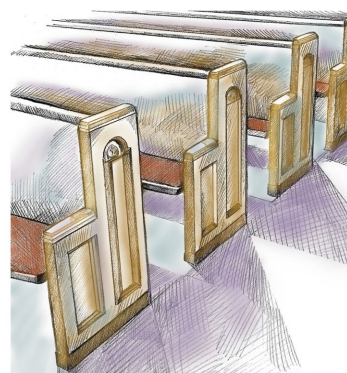
