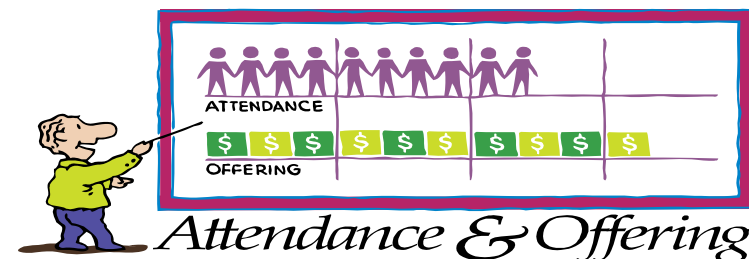

Michael Frank Rochelle of Hopkinsville, KY, age 77, passed away on September 4, 2023 at Vanderbilt University Medical Center, where he was also born in 1946, and was surrounded by his loving family. Friends nicknamed him Rock and his grandkids called him G-Daddy and Granddaddy. His personality was such a fun-loving man and made everyone enjoy being around him.

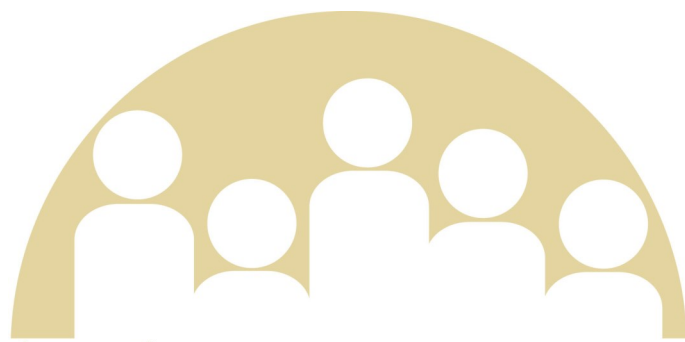
Kickoff Congregational Potluck meal will be at Southside today following our morning worship service. Meat and drinks are provided. Please join us!

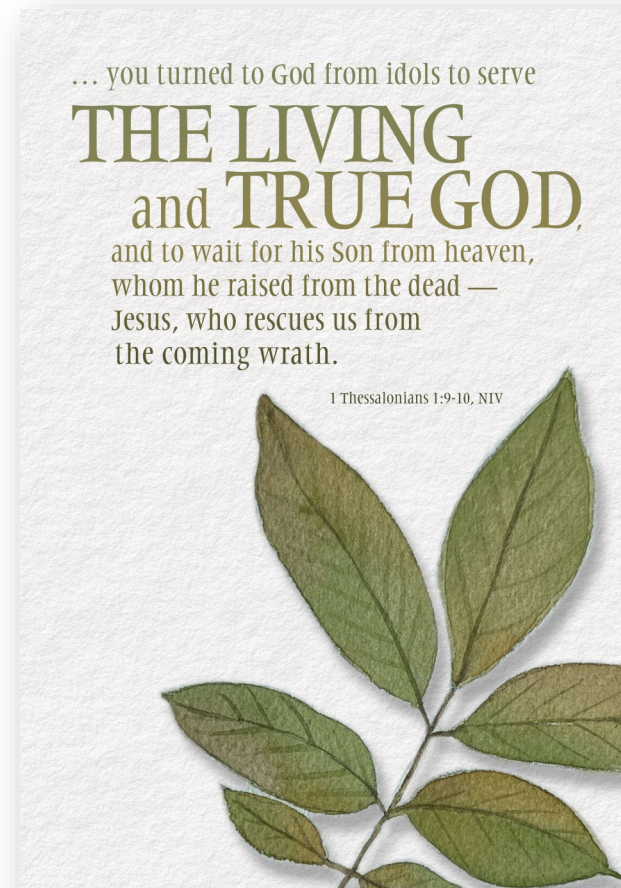


Backpacks for Africa 2023
