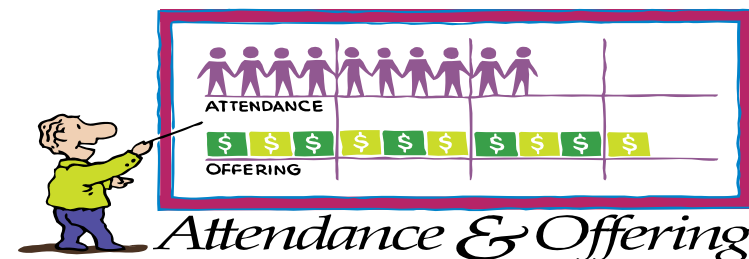

It's hard to know what to say here at the end of our time together. I've known that this was going to be my article to write for several days, and I've struggled to figure out what to say. But, my mind goes back to something I heard several years ago, and may have even shared with you before.

James Dobson, the founder of "Focus on the Family," was with Pete Maravich (the basketball player) when Pete died suddenly at the age of 40. As a result of this traumatic experience, Dobson and his family contemplated the uncertainty of life. Recognizing that nothing is guaranteed, they decided to give each other a simple reminder on a regular basis. They would give each other a thumbs up, and say, "Be there."

While none of us know when our last day on this earth may come, what we can know is where we'll spend eternity afterward. The Dobsons wanted to remind each other to be there - in heaven one day. Little of this life is in our control. Culture, climate, accidents, disease, economy, etc. etc. You're going to have good days and bad days. But, what you can do - what you can control - is whether or not you will "be there" in the end.

So, I want to leave you with this thought. I'm not moving to the other side of the world, so there's always a chance we will see each other again. You may come through South Carolina at some point. I might have the opportunity to visit Hopkinsville again. But, if we should happen not to see each other again this side of eternity ... be there. Whatever else may happen in this life ... be there. Make sure that you are prepared for eternity. Because I want to see you there!

"For we know that if the tent that is our earthly home is destroyed, we have a building from God, a house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens." (2 Corinthians 5:1) ... Be there!

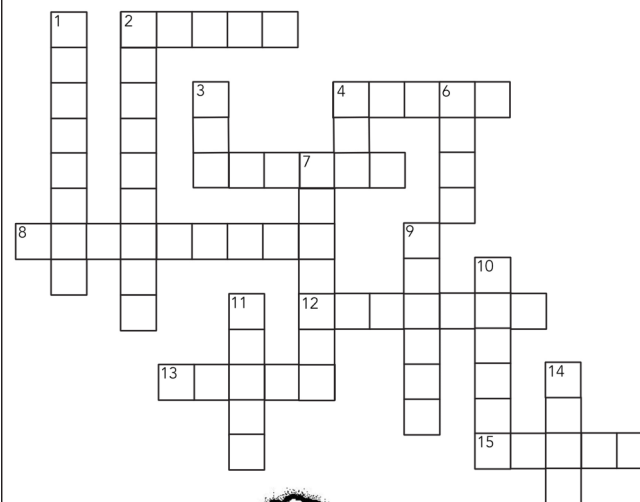
