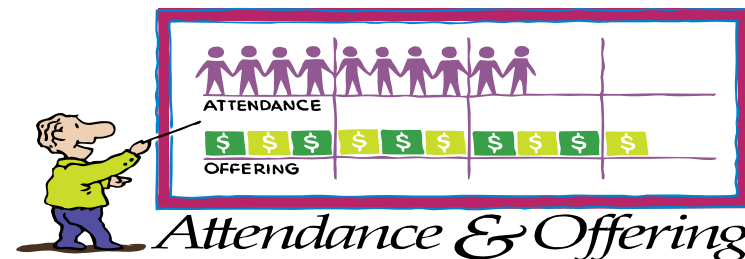

### PROVERBS FOR PARENTING

I'm sure every young parent wonders where they can find the "ULTIMATE, KNOW ALL TELL ALL BOOK," about how to raise their children up to be responsible, caring, stable adults? Well, you know what? There is a book out here that has been on the best seller list for year's and year's. It will not only help guide that new parent but also that teenager that is looking for answers to all their questions about life and why they are here. That young adult that is struggling to find their way in this world. The middle aged that are trying to navigate the empty nest and figuring out their relationship with their spouse, sans kids. There is even wisdom for those with lots of years of experience and wisdom of their own. Where can you find such a book you ask? There have been somewhere around 5 to 7 BILLION copies printed and I would venture a guess that if you are reading this article you already have one if not multiple copies of the BIBLE.

Everything we need to know about life, and how to navigate through it is contained within those pages, specifically contained in the book of proverbs. Solomon, has been reported to be the wisest man to ever live. If GOD saw fit for him to write down these nuggets of wisdom don't you think it might have been pretty important? Tim is doing a study on Wednesday nights going through proverbs chapter by chapter and if you are not there you are missing out. Since GOD originally created the family unit don't you think he would want to instruct mother's and father's how to raise their own families for generations to come? Let's just look at what Solomon passed on just about raising children.

*Proverbs 22:6 Train up a child in the way he should go and even when he is old he will not depart from it.*

We are responsible for their character training. Once they have been properly trained, they will be more inclined to respond in a Godly way because they will have a firm foundation.

Boy, this one can really open a can of worms can't it? I'm afraid that too many of us approach discipline and obedience from our children as optional. When we ignore disobedience we set our children up for an undisciplined life and vulnerable to a spirit of rebellion. In other words, we are setting them up for failure. We are not talking about nurturing abuse or breaking a child's spirit but GOD gave us those children to be their parent's and raise them up to know HIM... not to be another one of their buddies. This runs right in to the next proverb

*Proverbs 19:18 Discipline your son, for there is hope; do not set your heart on putting him to death*

When children are young their hearts are easily molded. They soak up all that they are exposed to and their hearts are still soft. As they get older that ability to mold their hearts diminishes drastically. Our job is to provide the correct training ground to prepare them for the situations they will encounter in the world. *Proverbs 20:7 The righteous who walks in his integrity-blessed are his children after him!*

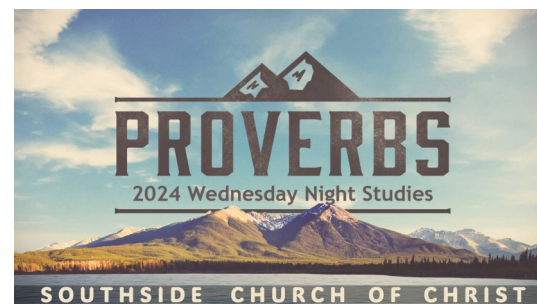
