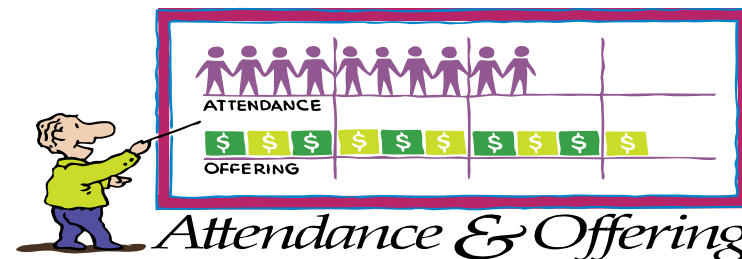

As I write this, my yet-to-be-completed NCAA National Tournament bracket sits on my desk in between some old bulletins and a Bible. I am considering praying for guidance and blessing over my selections since the USA Today has offered \$1,000,000 to anyone who correctly fills out a perfect bracket! It is estimated that 75 million people will enter; I have Kentucky beating Oakland, Texas Tech, Florida and Nebraska to advance into the Final Four, but I'm not so sure about what happens after that.

The interesting thing to realize is that the hopeful prospect of being right about sporting outcomes and a college game's score prediction comes from our Creator, in the way He made us. There is an innate human characteristic which deeply wants to win, and we want our team to win! This reality is on full display all around us and within us as our favorites compete for the big prize.

This morning Jackson will be preaching from Romans chapter 8, which presents Jesus as the ultimate Winner. Verse 31 reminds us of this perfect victory and asks, "If God is for us, who can be against us?" Christ came with an unbeatable force of everlasting love...not just by winning a playoff bracket or a championship trophy...but by winning a victory over all of LIFE, and even over death (v. 34).

As Christians, we will have setbacks and disappointments, dry spells, scoring droughts and even the occasional bracket-busting blow out (v. 35-36). But keep your hope alive in Christ because none of those distressing things mean that you have lost God's everlasting love! In fact, "*in all things we are more than conquerors*" (v. 37). Let's celebrate this most important victory and remember that our opponent, the devil, is not the winner of the great bracket of God's battle for you, nor for His Kingdom.


