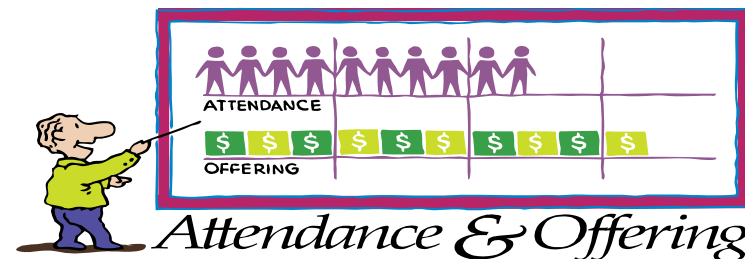

WHAT DOES Easter MEAN TO YOU?

When you ask the question "What does Easter mean to you?" there are many things that come to mind depending on the age, maturity and experiences of the person you are asking. Ask a young child what does Easter mean to you and you will get answers like chocolate, Easter eggs, egg hunts, bunnies, colorful baby chicks, and Easter baskets.

Ask a teenager and some of the answers will be similar to the young child--candy, Easter eggs, helping hide eggs for the younger children to hunt, and maybe eating Sunday lunch at a relative's house. Ask a mother or grandmother and you will get have to find new outfits for the children for church, planning and preparing a big meal, preparing Easter baskets, making sure that there are as many golden eggs at the egg hunt that there are children hunting eggs. I can't leave out we have one golden egg for each egg hunter so make sure each hunter only gets one golden egg.

Ask a Christian and you will get some similar answers but then the serious side of Easter starts to be talked about. Just like Christmas time reminds the world that Christ was born, Easter is a reminder our Lord and Savior was put to death and then was raised up, never to die again! The fact that the world recognizes this fact is truly amazing.

Christ fulfilled hundreds of Old Testament prophecies and many of these prophecies told of His death, burial and resurrection. Many of these prophecies tell of his suffering, of being innocent of any wrong doing, and being compared to a "lamb being led to the slaughter". Some of these we can't really relate to because we have never witnessed the everyday events that these prophecies talk about but the Jews certainly knew what these prophecies were referencing.

In the church of Christ, we remember His death, burial and resurrection each first day of the week when we participate in the Lord's supper. The elements in the Lord's supper were introduced to the Israelites when they were preparing to flee from captivity in Egypt and go to the land that God promised to them. When Christ was with the disciples having his last meal he told them that the unleavened bread represented His body and the fruit of the vine represented his blood that would be shed. Also, Christ's death, burial and resurrection is portrayed when a new Christian is baptized. That event represents the believer putting to death their old way of life, being buried and then rising up to begin a new walk as a Christian.

The word "Easter" means many things to different people. The main thing to remember is Christ suffered, was put to death and then conquered death by walking out of the tomb to fulfill a prophecy and give believing Christians the promise of an eternal life with Him in heaven. 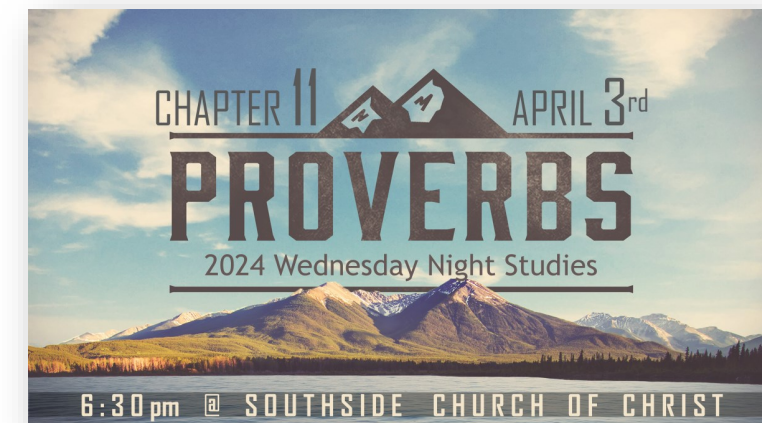
Gary Mahoney, former member and son of Ralph & Robin Mahoney, recently passed away in Franklin, TN.
