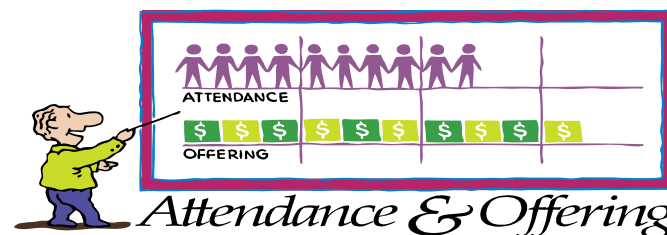

This weekend our youth group took a trip to Taylor Christian Camp in Holland, KY, a tiny town outside of Scottsville. It's the third year in a row of attending the annual Spring Retreat and each time it's a good reminder of how slowing down and spending time focusing on God with other teens is beneficial to our students. This year the theme was "Wilderness" and we focused on how spending secluded time with God is important for our growth as a Christian. Multiple times throughout the Gospels we see Jesus separate himself from his group so intentionally spend time with God in prayer. Kind of like his own personal retreat.

The goal for the weekend was to show kids that being alone with God is a good thing. Sometimes we fear being alone because that's when we feel like we are weakest, when we are most subject to sin, or most likely to mess up. Accountability is comforting and when we have that with others, great, but we can't let that be the only thing that keeps us on the 'straight and narrow'. We need to foster our relationship with God, we need to spend time with him so we can get to know him—and the best way to do that is to spend time praying with God and reading about his works, and it doesn't hurt to do it in one on one sessions. Just you and God.

The main narrative for the weekend retreat that we focused on in our group sessions was the story of the temptation of Jesus in Matthew 4. Jesus has been in the wilderness for forty days fasting and praying. He's about to come out of the wilderness to start his ministry, but right before he does he has an interaction with Satan. Three times Satan tempts Jesus, three times Jesus resists. Jesus was alone and hungry, but instead of succumbing to the temptations that Satan put before him, Jesus was strong and filled with God, giving him the ability to remain steadfast.

We need to be filled with God. We need to go into the wilderness and spend time with him, going in hungry for a relationship with a loving father, and coming out ready to share the bountiful meal of the Gospel. And that was the final goal of our weekend at Spring Retreat. We wanted our kids to understand that the 'wilderness' or the 'retreat' with God is necessary to grow, but that at some point we must come out of the 'wilderness,' just like Jesus did, so we can share the Gospel.

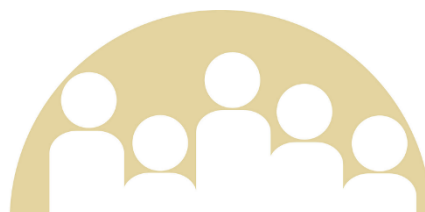
