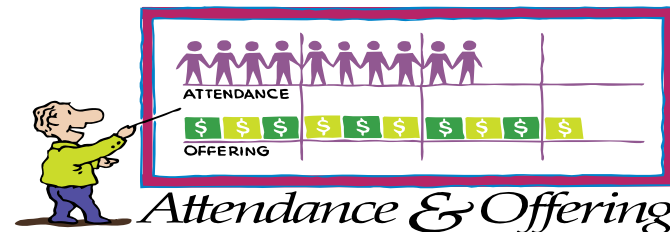

## IN FLANDERS FIELDS

From 1914 to 1918, Flanders Fields was a major battle theatre on the Western Front during the First World War. A million soldiers from more than 50 different countries were wounded, missing, or killed in action here. Entire cities and villages were destroyed, their population scattered across Europe and beyond.

The artillery shells that churned up the soil and maimed and killed soldiers, encouraged the proliferation and growth of the dormant poppy seeds that later in their beauty, bloomed on the barren, scarred land, even in the cemeteries.

There used to be a time where Americans wore Red Poppy pins like the one pictured "Lest they not Forget" the sacrifice made by the men and women during that Great War. In 1968, Congress passed the Uniform Monday Holiday Act to make Memorial Day the last Monday in May in 1971. Now we remember all our fallen heroes on this day from every war or conflict in our nation's history, not just World War I.



As Christians we celebrate and remember our most famous "hero" our Savior, Jesus Christ every Sunday. We don't wear a pin or some other symbol on our collars to remember Christ's sacrifice. Instead, we use perishable symbols like "bread" and "wine" to commune together this great sacrifice that Christ made for all of us. The pattern in scripture shows the early Christians "breaking bread" often. In Acts 20:7, Paul "breaks bread" with the disciples in Troas. Later, in I Corinthians 11, Paul was concerned about the Corinthians practice of "breaking bread" and urged them to do it together with one another and wait for all to participate.

This memorial of our Savior's sacrifice is an important part of our gathering and worship on each Lord's Day. It is up to us to make it special and not allow it to become routine. Christ has saved us from our sins for all eternity for those that have heard, believed, confessed, repented, and been baptized to become a part of His body.

As we remember those that have fallen while sacrificing it all to give us the freedom to assemble and worship in this country, let us not forget the "One" that saved us FOREVER with His sacrifice to save us from sin.

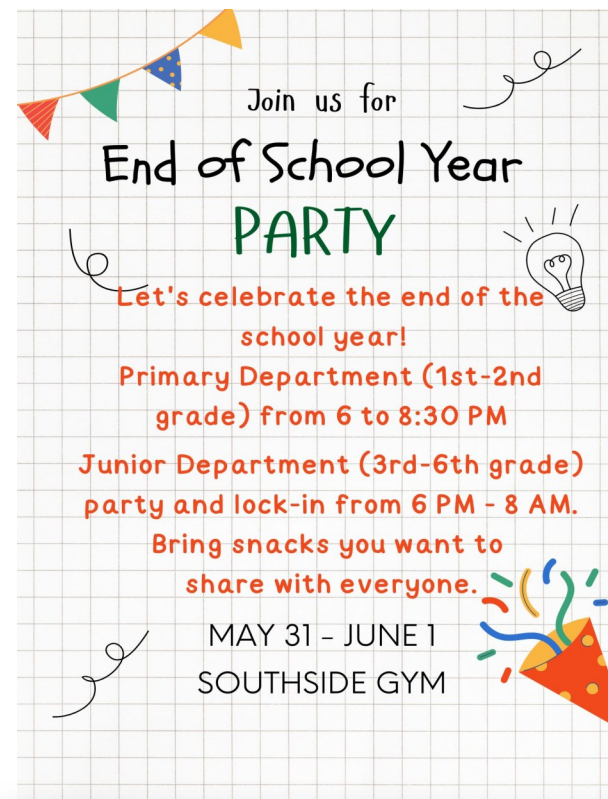
