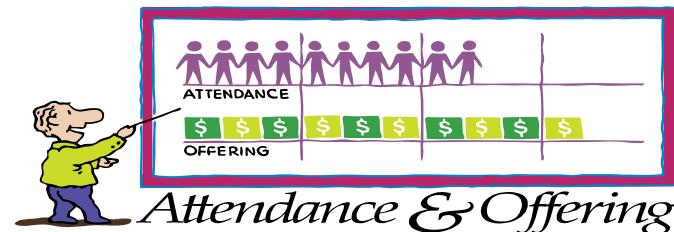

THE REST OF THE STORY BY PAUL HARVEY

Most of you have probably heard this recording by Paul Harvey, but I happened to run across the transcript this week and it made much more of an impact reading the words that he wrote in 1965. If you were around in 65, you will recognize Paul as the voice on the radio that told the REST OF THE STORY. Well, he wrote this before Vietnam, mini skirts and the sexual revolution had changed the way the country looked at some of these issues. I thought it was worth repeating.

If I were the prince of darkness, I'd want to engulf the whole world in darkness. And I would have a third of the real estate, and four-fifths of its population, but I wouldn't be happy until I had seized the ripest apple on the tree--- THEE!

So, I'd set about however necessary to take over the United States. I'd subvert the churches first. I'd begin with a campaign of whispers. With the wisdom of a serpent, I would whisper to you as I whispered to Eve: Do as you please.

To the young. I would whisper that 'The Bible is a myth' I would convince them that man created God instead of the other way around. I would confide that what's bad is good, and what's good is 'square'. And the old I would teach to pray after me. 'Our Father, which art in Washington...'

And then I'd get organized. I'd educate authors in how to make lurid literature exciting, so that anything else would appear dull and uninteresting. I'd threaten TV with dirtier movies and vice versa. I'd pedal narcotics to whom I could. I'd sell alcohol to ladies and gentlemen of distinction. I'd tranquilize the rest with pills.

If I were the devil, I'd soon have families at war with themselves, churches at war with themselves and nations at war with themselves; until each in it's turn was consumed. And with promises of higher ratings, I'd have mesmerizing media fanning the flames. If I were the devil I would encourage schools to refine young intellects, but neglect to discipline emotions—just let those run wild, until before you knew it you would have drug sniffing dogs and metal detectors at every schoolhouse door.

Within a decade I'd have prisons overflowing. I'd have judges promoting pornography--- soon I could evict GOD from the courthouse, then from the schoolhouse, and then from the houses of Congress. And in HIS own churches I would substitute psychology for religion and defy science. I would lure priests and pastors into misusing boys and girls, and church money. If I were the devil, I'd make the symbols of Easter an egg and the symbol of Christmas a bottle.

If I were the devil, I'd take from those that have and give to those who want until I had killed the incentive of the ambitious. And what do you bet I could get whole states to promote gambling as a way to get rich? I would caution against extremes and hard work in Patriotism and in moral conduct. I would convince the young that marriage is old fashioned, that swinging is more fun, that what you see on the TV is the way to be. And thus, I could undress you in public, and I could lure you into bed with diseases for which there is no cure.

IN OTHER WORDS , IF I WERE THE DEVIL I'D JUST KEEP RIGHT ON DOING WHAT HE IS DOING!
Read this over again and just think about when he wrote this. How outlandish the average person thought these predictions were. Looks like the old devil is following the script. And while he is trying his best to fill the roster in hell.... AS CHRISTIANS WE WIN!! And that is the REST OF THE STORY
