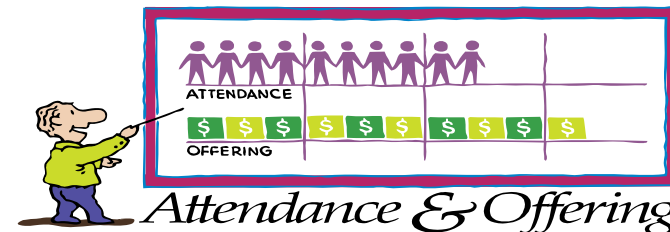

Greetings to all my brothers, in the Lord Jesus Christ our SAVIOR. BELOVED ONES, I have wanted to write to you sooner but I have been sick for several weeks. I have problems with sciatica, I had a lot of difficulty walking, a lot of pain in my right leg. The doctors gave me a checkup, x-rays, MRIs, etc. There was no medicine to explain the pain in my entire leg. The pain started in the lower back and continued throughout the leg. The doctors recommend a lot of rest and, perhaps with time there will be improvement, pray for me brothers, "the prayer of the righteous can do much." Lately, I'm feeling less pain and can walk inside my house. I am turning 68, perhaps what is happening to me is the ailments of old age. The doctors say that there are problems with some vertebrae, wear and tear... In addition, my wife is suffering from Alzheimer's and I have to be aware of her movements. Our daughters came and are with us. They are aware of our sufferings. They will be at home with us for fifteen days. The youngest daughter is living here, near us. One lives in Costa Rica and the other in London, England. The church that meets in our house continues to believe in the Lord Jesus Christ and preach with his life and the word of Christ. Due to my illnesses, I had to look for a brother to help me with the other congregations that are far from my home. There are three congregations. Brother Mauricio is living with them in the jungle, it is a place that is difficult to access. I talk to him when I can. Brothers, BELOVED, thank you for your prayers and for your financial help. We'll be in touch. God bless you all, amen.
