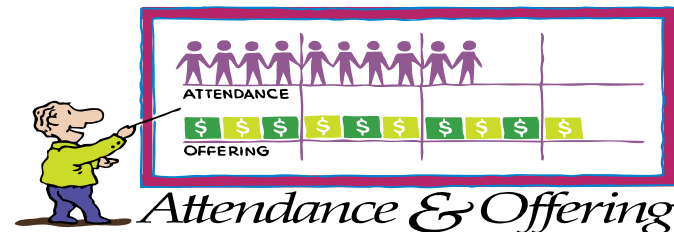

## COSTA RICA MISSION REPORT

Dear brothers in Christ.

I wish that you all are enjoying good health and many blessings of the Lord. Thanks to the Lord we are well.

I'm excited to tell you about the work done during our gospel meeting here in Liberia.

First, we had to change the date of the gospel meeting. Initially, we were going to do it on July 23rd thru 25th, however the rainy season severe this year in Liberia during the month of July and the church building had some problems with leaks in the roof. We decided that it was better to do the gospel meeting a month after, so we had it on August 23rd thru 25th, and by the grace of the Lord it did not rain during those three days!

The Church here in Liberia was well-prepared, we were all working very closely and delegating responsibilities to each one. We did door knocking with the help of brothers from surrounding Churches from Upala (60mi from Liberia), Tilaran (45mi from Liberia), Cañas (30mi from Liberia) and local brothers from Liberia.

Two brothers from Tilaran and Cañas preached four times during those days, and I preached on Friday night and Sunday morning.

Sisters organized themselves during those 3 days to cook the food as well as to take care of children's activities; they taught 4 lessons in the summer school. I tell you brothers, there are two sisters, Maryit and Yarlieth, who are very talented, and they made the murals for the lessons of Noah and Jonah, the lessons of the Prodigal Son and the Feeding of the Five thousand, they were taught with the help of the flannel board.

During the gospel meeting a sister was reconciled and 3 people who visited us expressed their desire to know more about the Church. I ask for your prayers for these souls who want to know more about the Lord.

Brothers, the Liberia Church is very grateful to the Southside Church for the help provided for the gospel meeting. Thanks to the money, we were able to cover food expenses and help with fuel for some far away brothers that accompanied us.

I, brothers, cannot stop thanking you because you are always willing to encourage me and help me in my work here in Liberia.

We would love to hold these activities with you all. It would be really encouraging if you plan a visit to Liberia again to do a gospel meeting along with a VBS. I'm sure it would be a great time to enjoy together as a big church family.

You are always in my prayers, and I know that you also pray for us as well.

I am sending you photos and videos of the gospel meeting.

# IN NEED OF PRAYER

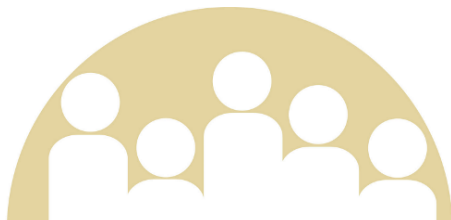
