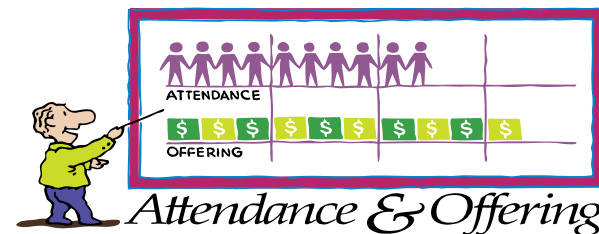

Good Morning Southside Family!

My name is Roy Staley, your friendly-neighborhood-technology-guy. As of this writing, I've been a member at Southside Church of Christ for 16,043 days, 14 hours, 15 minutes and 53 seconds, which is a very geeky way of saying "I grew up at Southside". My family has been attending Southside since it was founded in 1960 with my grandfather (Francis Swain) being a charter elder, my uncle (Dennis Swain) being a former elder, and my father (Ed Staley) being a current elder. I really do consider this church part of my family as I've known many of you practically my whole life.

As far as Audio / Video work goes I've learned from a long line of church AV men. My grandfather ran sound at Hendersonville Church of Christ and my father, along with Paul Hostilo, ran sound here at Southside for many years and taught me a lot. I am now training another generation of Staleys to run the AV systems at church.

In college I worked for the Entertainment and Technical Services department at Lipscomb and ended up running sound or stage lighting for most events on campus like daily chapel, Singarama, and for groups who would perform on campus including Acappella, Casting Crowns, and even Diamond Rio.

If you are not comfortable getting up in front of people, serving others by helping out with the AV and Technology needs would be a great opportunity. We are always looking for people who want to learn how things work.
