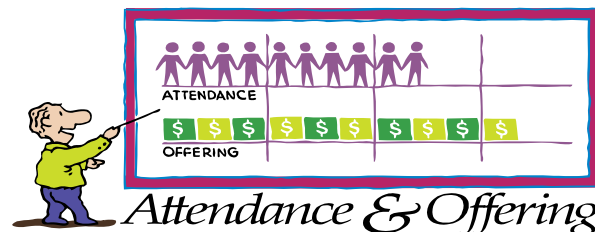

Topics like abortion, marriage, same sex unions, paying our debts, and loving our neighbors. Romans 3:1 states that there is no authority except God's authority and those that exist have been instituted by God.

We can take solace that God is still in charge no matter who wins this election, but we also have to take into account that God is looking at us personally as we support values and agendas. Do we align ourselves on Election Day with certain values that we confess not to support in our lives or at our church services? Religious freedom is something we should never take for granted. A quote from John Quincy Adams states that duty is ours and results are God's.

Voting, like so many other issues, truly reveals what's in our hearts.

On another note, fall is a special time of year. Pumpkins, haybales, falling leaves, harvest moons, football, the World Series, UK basketball and fall fellowships. We are so grateful to the Parkers for allowing our church family and friends to come together for a time of fellowship and to experience the beauty of this time of year.
