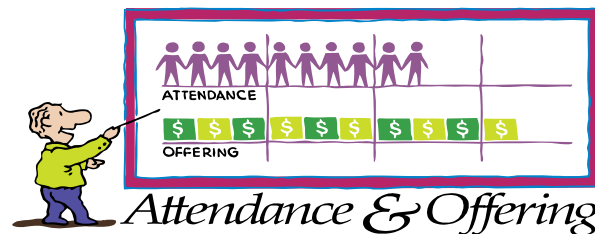

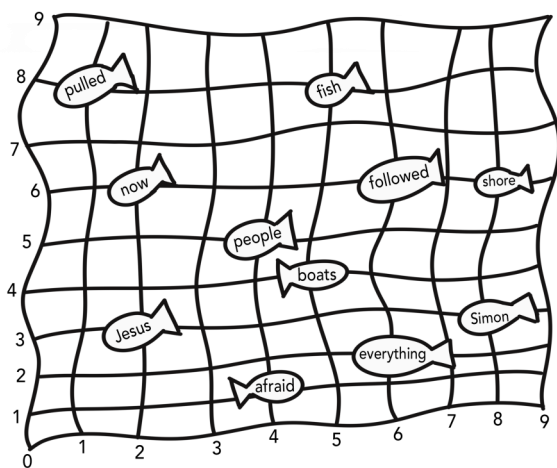


# PUZZLE
