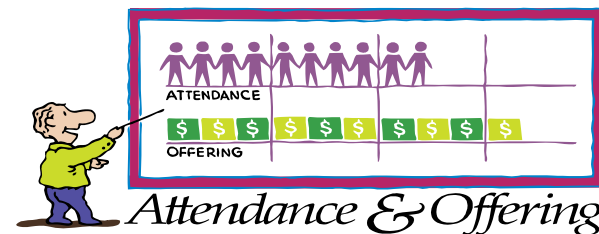

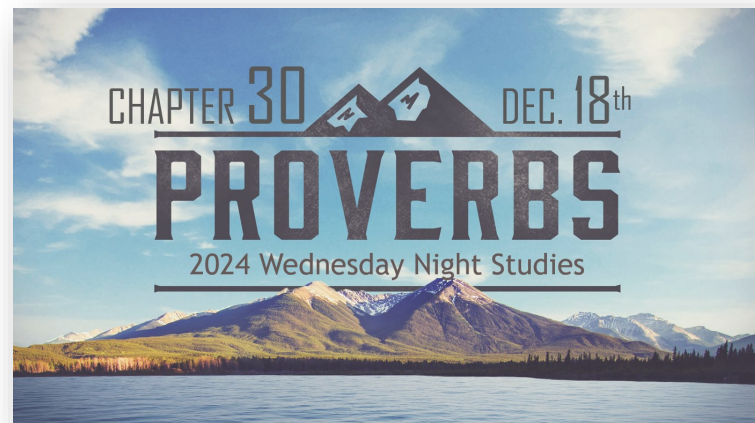
The snack basket was a wonderful surprise for Bob. If anyone knows him, they know he likes snacks.

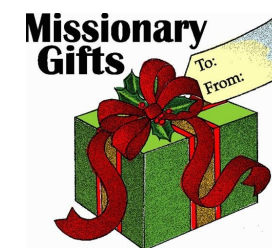


Sew Sisters Work Day
