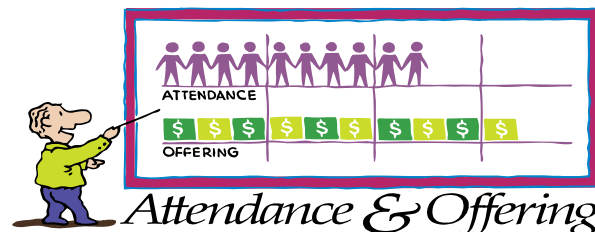

Good Morning Southside Family!

I'm Donna Pickerill, Kingdom Kids Coordinator. I am from Elkton, KY where I grew up attending Westside Church of Christ. After graduating from college, I moved to Hopkinsville and joined Southside. I have been married to my husband, Bob, for 40 years and we have 2 children, Shane and Carrie. Shane, Leann and their children, Allie (20) and Logan (17), live in Paris, KY. Carrie, Tyler and their children Cohen (9) and Caroline (6) live in Hopkinsville and are members of Southside.



In 2019, I retired from my job as Controller at White Drive Products. In June 2021, I was asked by the elders to take over the children's curriculum. Lindsey Howell had been filling this role and was going back to work after staying home with her children for several years. I was humbled, excited and a little nervous to take over this role.

I contacted 10 churches to see what curriculum was being used. We wanted a curriculum that taught the Bible—not just individual Bible “stories” but how the Old Testament links to Jesus with a strong focus on the love of Jesus in the New Testament. We also wanted a curriculum that would interest our children. The curriculum that was most exciting was a “home-grown” curriculum that was being used by Franklin and Crittenden Drive Churches of Christ. This curriculum is chronological through the Bible. The big difference is the way the lessons were taught. The students study one lesson for 2 weeks. During these 2 weeks, the students go to a different classroom each Sunday and Wednesday night. A group of elders, deacons and others visited Crittenden Drive to see these classrooms. We left excited and committed to implementing this program at Southside with the name of Kingdom Kids.

With the elders' encouragement and approval, all classrooms were painted, murals were painted and carpet was replaced. The halls became “store fronts” and one classroom was transformed into a theater. This could not have happened without Marvin Maxwell, Jackson Wells and Peyton Crump.

In September 2022, we began our new curriculum. Much to our relief, it was a great success with the students and the teachers. Teachers love teaching for 2-weeks versus an entire quarter and they also enjoy selecting the classroom in which to teach. The students love going into a different classroom each week and they all have their “favorite” classroom.

Our classrooms consist of:

Holy Word Theater-the lesson is taught then the students watch a video of the lesson or act out the lesson with a skit. We have some potential actors in our congregation!

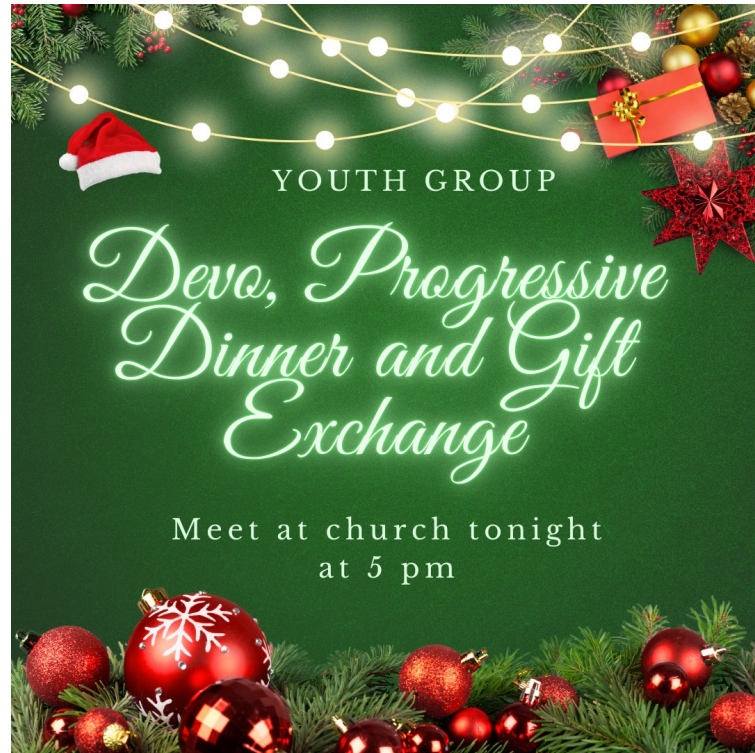
Daily Prophet-the lesson is taught and the students use iPads to play Kahoot. Kahoot is a multiple choice game on the iPad with questions from the lesson. Students score points for how quickly they answer a question and for correct answers. The competition can get intense! (continued on Page 2)

Creation Station-the lesson is taught and the students make a craft related to the lesson. They especially enjoy the crafts that involve food!

Noah's Arkade-the lesson is taught and the students take turns playing a game after answering a question from the lesson. If you feel the church shake during class, it's probably from this classroom!

We are always looking for more teachers so please consider this important work. One benefit of these rotations is teachers get to know ALL our students, not just one age group. We are blessed with so many children at Southside and you are missing out if you don't get to know them!

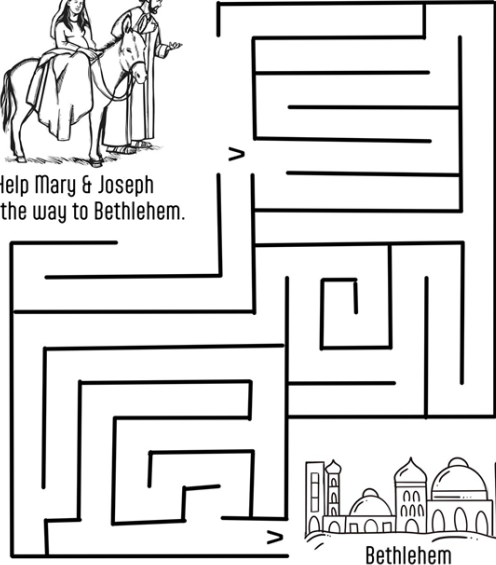

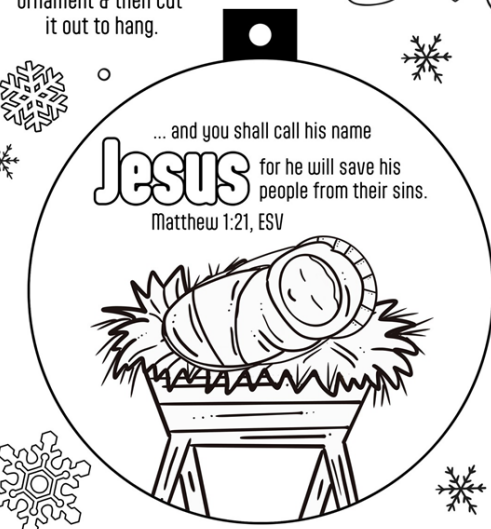

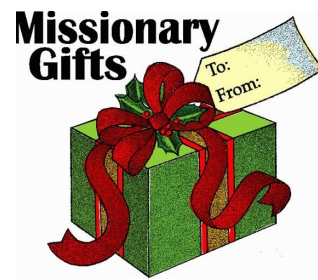

Clay and Debbie Green back to our family! The Greens responded to the invitation last Sunday and placed membership. Be sure and welcome them!

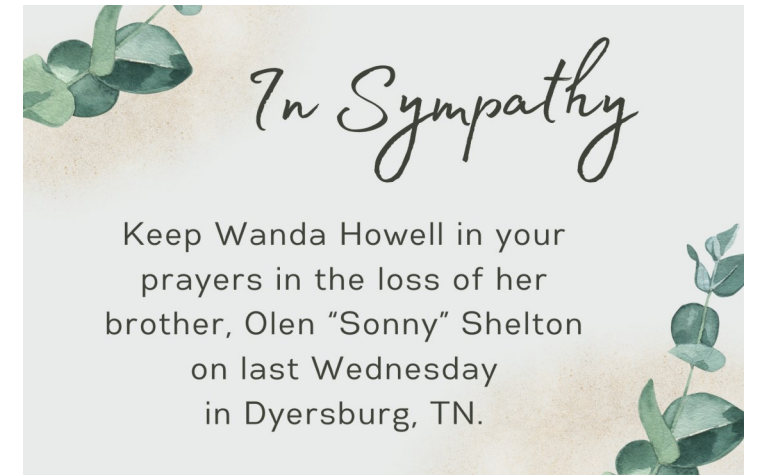


Ricardo is our missionary in Costa Rica.
