The Churches of Christ remain firm in their faith towards our Lord and Savior, we have been evangelizing other nearby communities, we have had to stop due to a new outbreak of disease, apparently brought by immigrants from other countries, a few have already died and a few others are sick, the brother who works with me is sick and we had to bring him to the capital city. The government is being diligent in these communities, trying to eradicate this evil, produced by a mosquito. There are restrictions to enter and leave the village. I was visiting another congregation of 60 members, this congregation is 1 hour by car and 9 hours walking from my house. We brought them clothes for men, women and children. I attached photos. The political situation in our country is becoming hostile because of the Panama Canal. Beloved, my wife and I are not in very good health, perhaps, ailments of old age. The congregation that meets in my house, all preaching with the Bible and with our conduct. Brothers, thank you for your Christian love and for your constant financial help. May our almighty God shower you with rich blessings.

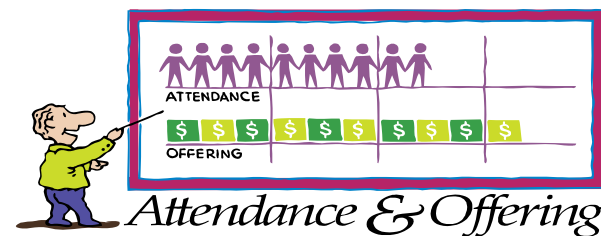
